INTRODUCTION
Welcome to the TarValon.net 21st Anniversary event! This should be the largest attendance we've had in more than 5 years. Thank you all for attending, we can't wait to see you all.
ABOUT FALL CREEK FALLS STATE PARK
Fall Creek Falls is in rural east Tennessee. The nearest small towns are Spencer and Pikeville. I recommend that you do any shopping in Chattanooga, Nashville, or Knoxville on your way in as there really isn't much in the way of shopping/stores available. Pikeville has a very small Piggly Wiggly, along with a few places to eat (The Butter Dish, a pizza place, McDonalds). Spencer has a Save-a-Lot.
The park itself is beautiful and large, at almost 30,000 acres. Perched across the eastern edge of the Cumberland Plateau Fall Creek Falls State Park is named for its 256 foot tall waterfall, one of the highest in all of eastern North America. Camping, hiking, fishing, and golf are some of


AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION ————


Nashville or Chattanooga via Atlanta are the best ways to arrive via airplane. Knoxville is also close but tends to be more expensive than the other two.

Check in begins at **4:00pm** central - **please do not arrive on site prior to 4pm**. (Some members may be specifically instructed to arrive earlier - that's okay.)

If you are not specifically instructed to arrive earlier than 4pm central - please don't. Everyone who is at the site early will be busy getting the site ready for us, so try & be patient. Check in will be at the Recreation Hall in the park. Unfortunately they don't have a map that shows any of this in a usable form, but if you stop at the visitors center, they'll be able to direct you, or we'll have someone there to show you where to go. You can always call one of us as well!

If you'd like to hang out with other party goers before the scheduled check-in time, there are a few local places you can stop & try out. We thought these places might appeal:

From Nashville: Looks like McMinnville is your best bet coming from Nashville. The three most appealing seem to be Applebee's, MudBums Sports Grill, or Wild Bill's BBQ & Grill.

From Chattanooga: Monkey Town Brewing in Dayton looks like a nice brewpub, though it is a little out of the way. Try El Metate in Dunlap if you want a pitstop that's more on the direct route.
