INTRODUCTION

Over the last 15 years TarValon.Net has grown into an international organization known for its acts of service and fundraising, its members brought together by their enjoyment of *The Wheel of Time* series by Robert Jordan and Brandon Sanderson. This year we celebrate with a house party in Placerville — our celebrations will be held on the property where our organization was founded. This event will be more intimate than those in our recent past, and attendees are overwhelmingly community long-timers.

It's been a long time since Eleyan was able to invite everyone to her house for the weekend. It's time to do it again!

ABOUT PLACERVILLE

Placerville is the California Gold Rush Town that every depiction in literature or film is based on. It's the Seat of El Dorado County. The Town has been known by many names, including Dry Diggings and Hangtown. The last one is still used, and a hanging effigy in town doesn't let you forget it. Placerville is about 20 minutes from the Gold Discovery site at Coloma (now a state park), and the city itself is a warren of mines and passages. The history is quite colorful. Our event location and primary hotel are walking distance to one another. Downtown's 3 city blocks are filled with restaurants, bars, antique stores, curiosity shops, book stores, vintners, bakers, cafes, civic buildings and local museums. There are several grocery stores within a few miles. Placerville is a "foodie" town, so it is possible to find restaurants that accommodate special diets.

Placerville is about 1.5 hours from South Lake Tahoe and about 1 hour from Sacramento. Both locations are well worth exploring for both their historical and natural beauty.

AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION

You are responsible for your transportation to and from the event. You must arrange your pick-up and drop-off information before you arrive at the event. The closest major airport is Sacramento International (SMF). Placerville is also served by Greyhound Bus Service. If you are traveling by car with other members (even if just for part of your journey), please be sure to pitch in for fuel. Be sure to exchange phone numbers with your travel partners in advance! The airport is approximately 1 hour away from Placerville, depending on traffic.

EVENT CHECK-IN

Check in at the Glen Morey Country House between 4–7 PM. If you arrive earlier in the day, meet us for drinks at the Cary House Hotel Lobby. If you're coming in later, let us know and we'll look out for you!

EVENT PARKING

Guests will need to park either at the Cary House Hotel or with the closest municipal parking lot (on this map, the Cary House is across from City Hall). This parking lot is very close to the Glen Morey Country House (about 1.5 blocks). Only those attendees staying at the Glen Morey House may park in the lot there. Drop-offs and pick-ups are allowed, and if you need special accessibility, please let us know and we will make arrangements.

DEPARTURE

We must be completely checked out by 10 AM Monday. We ask that everyone pitch in Sunday evening to clean up the Glen Morey Country House. Monday morning, we will proceed to IHOP for brunch.

Noon – 4 PM: Meet-n-Greet at the Cary House Hotel Lobby.

Come ease yourself into our social weekend with relaxed conversation and a drink at the Cary House Hotel lobby bar.

4 PM - 7 PM: Check in at the Morey House/Dinner Break.

Figure out how to get to our event space while it's still light enough outside to see where you're going! Volunteer for competitions and sign waivers that will let you play with pointy-ish objects! Hang around at the house or go grab dinner out on the town before the party gets into full swing.

7 PM – 10 PM (approx): The Olde Warder and Hen, Opening Ceremonies & Amyrlin's Tournament Part 1: A Test of Intelligence (aka Trivia!)

HEALTH AND SAFETY

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Members and guests will be held accountable for their behavior as outlined in our Code of Conduct: "All attending a TarValon.Net function must behave in full accordance with this constitution and the Code of Conduct. Members who fail to comply may be asked to leave the event and will not be granted a refund. If disciplinary action is needed at a real life event, it may result in termination of membership. Members must act as responsible guests. This includes respecting personal property and space, as well as helping with set-up, clean-up, and costs."
- Be respectful of personal space. Everyone is a little different, get to know someone before you touch, hug, cuddle, or otherwise invade someone else's "personal space."
- No person under the age of 21 may consume alcohol at the event. No member or guest under the age of 18 may smoke. It is not legal to consume marijuana recreationally in California.
- You may not bring a guest who was not previously approved through our guest list.
- Smokers are asked to smoke only in designated smoking areas. These areas will be outdoors. Dispose of cigarette butts and ashes appropriately.
- No one may handle a sword if they appear intoxicated. Anyone found handling a weapon
 in an inappropriate or threatening manner will be asked to leave the function without
 refund
- If you want to participate in an activity, please arrive on time.
- All members must comply with requests of administration. Please note, administrators
 were chosen very carefully for this event. They are not the sort of people to make
 arbitrary requests and support both your personal responsibility and privacy. If an
 administrator asks you to change a behavior it is because they perceive considerable
 risk to yourself or others involved. Refusal to comply may result in your being asked to
 leave the event without refund.
