
- International shipping is **prohibitive**, unfortunately.







- I don't spend enough time online to follow on social media




Is there anything you would change about the mentorship program?

 actually even knows who has applied in the past.
- I think that **some members could receive mentors earlier.** I would have loved having a mentor as a citizen rather than waiting those twelve weeks before I entered the tower.
- Both times I have had a mentor **they seem to drop off after a while.** Now my second mentor and I did talk more which I liked a lot. Maybe there needs to be a different way to match people? I know life gets busy and some people are getting two mentors now so I'm not sure. My two times as a mentor where both very different. One went awol and the other I talk to a whole lot still. I feel like **my second mentee and I really clicked**;)
- Make it understood that **mentorship should be beyond Novice/Recruit**, and should be until the person becomes a Senior Member themselves. If that is not the rule, then consider making that a rule, because **quite a few JMs feel abandoned** a bit when the get to Tier 2 and suddenly this person who was there for them disappears.






- I get disconnected from IRC a lot (Firefox/Mac OS) while working on projects. That's the main reason I don't use it.




